**Deadline**

Applications must be submitted and received by the Transportation Department no later than 4:00 P.M. on Monday, April 3, 2017.

**A Student Transportation Application must be submitted every year for each child.**

Additional applications may be obtained from the Transportation Office or by downloading an application from the Transportation page of the District website ([www.mamkschools.org](http://www.mamkschools.org)).

Eligibility: K-8 grade students must live more than two and less than fifteen miles from school; 9-12 grade students must live more than three and less than fifteen miles from school, as measured by the Mamaroneck U.F.S.D. Transportation Department. Parents not residing in the District on April 1, 2017 must submit application(s) within 30 days of establishing residence in the District. Proof of residency is required.
