## **Modified Baseball Information**

\*All kids must be electronically registered and cleared by the school nurse through Family ID in order to participate - there will be no exceptions! Kids must also fill out the Covid Attestation form provided by the district each day. You can access this form on the district website or can scan any QR code located at various entrances to the school building (and at Flint Park).

<u>Please have your child fill out the Daily Attestation form PRIOR to arriving</u> and show me the form upon arrival (doing this beforehand will allow us to maximize the time we have for tryouts). This form must be completed for athletics each day. This means you will complete the one emailed to you in the morning for school and then this link for after school each day.

\*Due to the large number of kids trying out, the following schedule will be used for the first three days of tryouts:

Mon, May 3rd - 8th Grade: 3:05 - 4:157th Grade: 4:15 - 5:30Tues, May 4th - 7th Grade: 3:05 - 4:158th Grade: 4:15 - 5:30Wed, May 5th - 8th Grade: 3:05 - 4:157th Grade: 4:15 - 5:30

\*Please be aware that if your child plans on pitching/catching during tryouts, they will most likely stay past 5:30, as this happens at the end of each practice session.

\*Please have your child fill out this form as soon as possible: <u>Modified Baseball</u> <u>Player Form</u>

\*On Monday, May 3rd, <u>we will meet in the Hommocks Gym</u>. Kids should arrive five minutes before their scheduled practice is supposed to start (with attestation forms ready).

\*Kids should be prepared for both warm/cold weather. Regardless of how cold it is, we will be outside (either in the batting cage or on the field at Flint Park), as long as it is not raining.

\*Kids should bring both sneakers and cleats (*metal cleats <u>are not</u> allowed*). On Monday, kids should start in their sneakers and can then change into their cleats if we go to Flint Park to use the field.

\*Kids should bring their own equipment (glove, helmet, water bottle) needed for practice each day & must wear a mask at all times!

\*Kids <u>**MUST</u>** use a -3 BBCOR bat during tryouts (bats can be shared with other kids, but will need to be sanitized after each use)</u>

\*Unfortunately, due to the large number of kids trying out, some kids will not be selected for the team. The selection process is certainly not an easy one. You can expect the coaching staff to be fair and objective during the tryout and selection process and base our decisions **solely on what we see during tryouts**. Each athlete is given a minimum of 3 days of tryouts. Our goal is to select student-athletes who will not only represent our school and community in a positive manner, but also help maintain the strong Mamaroneck Baseball tradition.
