



#### **The Design Thinking Process**



#### Two objectives. Two Outcomes.

- 1. Listen to and utilize knowledge of team members to create an authentic lesson.
- 2. Utilize knowledge of design thinking (place yourself in the shoes of the students) and high expectations teaching to design a cognitively engaging lesson.
- 3. Present lesson to the rest of the school.
- 4. Use what you have designed in an upcoming lesson.
- 5. Bonus: Invite others to see your lesson in action.
