2017-18 School Year Update



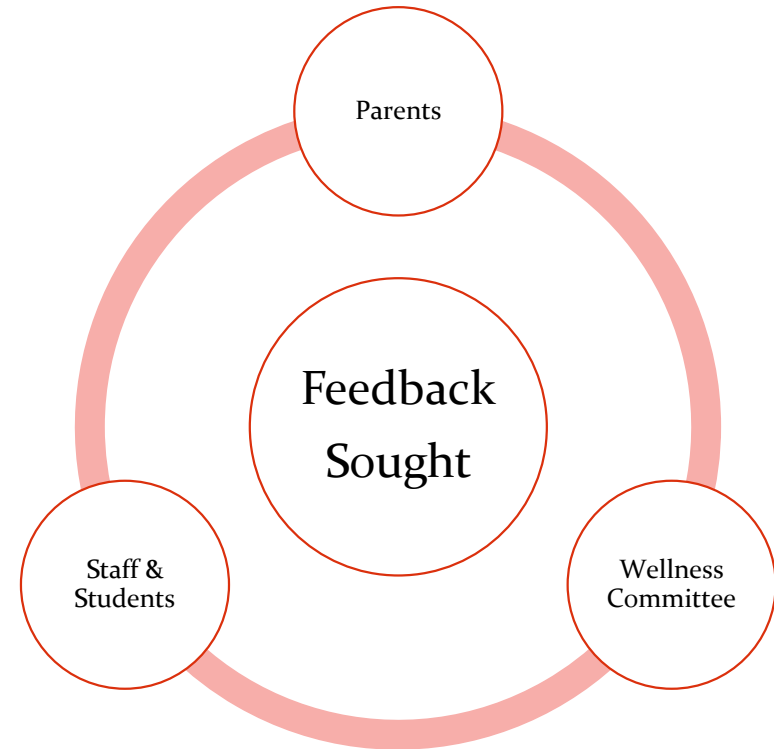


## 2017/18 School Lunch Program Changes

- With parental input, the Bid was revised for a higher-quality food menu including healthier snack choices.
- Aramark was awarded bid and District selects new School Lunch Director, Ms. Sandra Renken.
- District staff and weekly consultants monitor Aramark's adherence to the new contract.
- Food Sales are lower than last year, particularly for a la carte purchases. We only have the September data, so this will be monitored and reported on later in year.

## Ongoing efforts

- Input concerning menu, food quality and service will be sought.
- Internal Staff and External monitoring will continue.
- Work with District's Wellness Committee regarding food choices.
- Menu options may be revised as year goes on- some items are not great for transport to elementary programs.





## Continual Program Improvements

- New warming/cooling food delivery truck in 2017/18.
- Equipment and Serving Line on-site Analysis underway:
  - Review of all sites via tours in September included:
    - District and School Administrators
    - School Lunch Manager
    - School Lunch Program Consultant
    - Kitchen equipment and serving line layout expert
- Prioritized list of equipment purchases and repairs will be prepared and implemented.
